

SUBJECT: Public Hearing on Planning Application PA19-0209 for a Use Permit to allow for an alternative

to the County of Orange Parking requirement.

PROPOSAL: Use permit to propose an alternative to the required parking for a new apartment building. The use

permit is to allow for the construction of three fully covered parking spaces and two partially covered

parking spaces, where four fully covered parking spaces would otherwise be required

LOCATION: The project is located at 18802 E Vine St. in the Orange community, within the Third (3rd) Supervisorial

District. (APN 383-082-47)

ZONING: R4 "Suburban Multi-family"

APPLICANT: Sam Parsi

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION: Staff recommendation is to find that the proposed project is Categorically Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Class 3 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) pursuant to Section 15303 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines and County of Orange procedures.


