Subject: Notice of 2024-2027 OC Development Services Fee Schedule

In accordance with California Government Code 66017, this is a notice to the public of an update its Schedule of Fees for OC Development Services.


In previous actions by the Board of Supervisors (“the Board”), the Board approved Resolution 94-300 (March 22, 1994) establishing fees for encroachment on County property. On March 30, 2010, the Board approved Ordinance 10-008 adopting the fee schedule for Building and Safety, Planning, Subdivision, and Grading which was subsequently rescinded by approval of Resolution 15-017 on March 15, 2015. The last fee update was on July 14, 2020, wherein the Board approved and adopted Resolution 20-089.

OC Public Works is proposing to update its Schedule of Fees for Development Services including all fee categories from previous actions for fiscal years 2024-2025, 2025-2026 and 2026-2027, effective July 1, 2024. The fee schedule update is scheduled for a Board hearing date of May 7, 2024, details of which may be found on the Board of Supervisors website.

The new fee amounts and rates follow the Board adoption of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the period of June 30, 2023 to June 25, 2026 and reflect the Board-approved salary and benefit increases which have occurred since the last adjustment. The final fee amounts will be rounded to the nearest dollar per Resolution 94-300.
