The applicant is requesting a Use Permit from the Planning Commission to convert an existing detached garage into administrative office space and to propose alternative parking standards.

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

OC Development Services/Planning recommends the Planning Commission:

- 2. Find that the project is categorically exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Class 3 New Construction or Conversion of Small Structure pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303.
- 3. Approve Planning Application PA23-0217 for a Use Permit subject to the attached Findings (Attachment 1) and Conditions of Approval (Attachment 2).

Special Notes:

This item was presented by Ilene Lundfelt, Planner, County of Orange Development Services. Commissioner Bartlett visited the project site and met with the applicants. He requested that the Planning Commission check back in with the project only if any concerns are raised. Various comments were received about this project, mostly about parking and traffic issues. This project has the required parking spaces, no complaints have been received so far regarding street parking, and the County traffic engineer does not believe this project will create additional parking issues.

Public Hearing:

Nicole Cavanaugh, alumni of the program operated on site, spoke in approval of this project. She stated that allowing expansion of the facility will allow them to support for women requesting services.
