I live at [REDACTED], Corona del Mar. That is in the Cameo Highlands neighborhood. The proposed wireless communication facilities are proposed to be installed directly above my house. I am strongly in favor of this installation. For years my family has dealt with poor and sometimes non-existent cell phone access. I usually have to go outside and down the street to find an acceptable place to make a call. Not only that, I constantly miss important phone calls. I will notice missed calls and find I have a phone message even when my cell phone is sitting right next to me!

I have tried phone boosters and AT&T has been out to my house many times to try and help me. The reality is that there is no cell phone tower near this neighborhood that is strong enough for the residents to make or receive calls. I also believe there is a strong safety reason these towers will address. I have a terminally ill daughter-in-law living with me and I worry that I won't be able to call for emergency help. Emergency services should be able to contact the residences in this neighborhood and we should be able to reliably reach out when we need help.

Finally, to maintain the home values in this neighborhood we must have cell towers nearby. I already know of one family that did not move into this beautiful neighborhood because when they were looking at houses, they could not get a cell phone connection. Many people work from home these days. Reliable communication is a must!
