Dear Ms. Duggan,

I am writing to express my strong support for the proposed cell tower installation at the south end of Pelican Hill Golf Course. This infrastructure is critically needed to improve public safety and communication reliability in southern Corona del Mar.

Currently, several neighborhoods, including The Village, Corona Highlands, Shorecliffs, Cameo Shores, Pelican Point, and Crystal Cove beach, experience weak or inconsistent cellular coverage. This poses a serious risk during emergencies, as reliable service is essential for contacting 911. For instance, my wife and I frequently experience poor reception at home, which directly impacts our ability to access emergency services.

I understand that the tower will be appropriately camouflaged among mature trees, which will minimize its visual impact and ensure it blends effectively with the existing landscape.

I urge OC Public Works to approve this installation without delay to enhance emergency response capabilities and ensure critical communications for all residents and visitors in the area.
