RE: Hearing Regarding Use Permit for Saddleback Meadows Housing Development

I am writing in opposition to the issuance of a use permit for the 181-unit housing project. The development never should have been approved. Yes, housing is important, but it is folly to build 181-million-dollar units in a very high fire hazard severity zone. Think of the costs to the residents and the county if the residences are destroyed by wildfires like the Palisades and Altadena.
