ITEM #1 GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT T 19-01 – TRANSPORTATION ELEMENT, ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS.

Staff is requesting to adopt Planning Commission Resolution No. 19-04 recommending that the Board of Supervisors: (1) make the appropriate findings under the California Environmental Quality Act, and (2) adopt amendments to the County of Orange Circulation Plan, contained in the Transportation Element. The proposed amendments conform the Circulation Plan to the Orange County Master Plan of Arterial Highways (MPAH) administered by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), and conform the Bikeway Plan, contained in the Transportation Element with the OCTA Bikeway Collaborative Plan

Recommended Action(s):

1. Receive staff report and public testimony;
2. Adopt Planning Commission Resolution No. 19-04 recommending that the Board of Supervisors make the appropriate findings under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and adopt proposed General Plan Amendment T19-01 – Transportation Element that will update the County of Orange Circulation and Bikeway Plan.

ITEM #2 GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT T 19-02 – TRANSPORTATION ELEMENT, ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS.

Staff is requesting to adopt Planning Commission Resolution No. 19-05 recommending that the Board of Supervisors: (1) make the appropriate findings under the California Environmental Quality Act, and (2) adopt amendments to the County of Orange Circulation Plan, contained in the Transportation Element. The proposed Amendments remove from the Circulation Plan: (1) a portion of Graham Street (a conceptually proposed roadway), and (2) a portion of Talbert Street from the City of Huntington Beach (City) limits to its current terminus on the MPAH (a conceptually proposed roadway). These amendments are proposed to conform the Circulation Plan to the Orange County Master Plan of Arterial Highways (MPAH), administered by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA).

Recommended Action(s):

1. Receive staff report and public testimony;
2. Adopt Planning Commission Resolution No. 19-05 recommending that the Board of Supervisors make the appropriate findings under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and adopt proposed General Plan Amendment T19-02 – Transportation Element that will update the County of Orange Circulation Plan.
